2:00-4:00pm- March for Life!

4:30- Train leaves for Crystal Lake

5:51- Arrive back in Crystal Lake

Cost- Bring \$8 for train fare and money for lunch (or your own sack lunch).

Wear clothes that will keep you warm. We will be outside for about 3 hours, from approx. 1:30-4:30pm. I attended the march in Chicago a few years ago and it was one of the coldest days of the year, so I had on about 5 layers, a warm coat, gloves, hat, scarf, and hand warmers. So, please be sure you are dressed warm!! Wear shoes that you are comfortable in as well.

Mass is not included in this trip, so please either attend a vigil Mass or the 8am Mass. You may be able to attend the 9:30 Mass but that will be cutting it quite close. St. Thomas also has a 9am Mass, that I will most likely be attending.
